# Expression of Interest — Australian Team Selection

## Roller Freestyle World Championships 2025 (Park • Street • Street Junior)

Skate Australia invites Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from athletes seeking selection to represent Australia at the 2025 Roller Freestyle World Championships in the following divisions:

- **Park (Senior)**
- **Street (Senior)**
- **Street Junior** (age eligibility per World Skate rules)

Because there are **no domestic qualifying events** for these championships, selection will be based on:

1. a results CV from **2024 and 2025** competitions, and
2. a **video submission** demonstrating current skill and competition-readiness.

EOIs will be assessed by the CEO to confirm athletes meet an appropriate performance standard for World Championship competition.

## Key Dates

- **EOI deadline: 5:00 pm, Monday 1 September 2025 (AEST)**
- **Selections finalised: by 5:00 pm, Monday 8 September 2025 (AEST)**
- **Notification:** Athletes offered a place will be contacted directly by Skate Australia following the selection decision.

## Eligibility (summary)

- Must be an **Australian citizen** or otherwise eligible to represent Australia under World Skate rules.
- **Current Skate Australia member** in good standing.
- Meet **age requirements** for the division entered (Street Junior per World Skate rules).
- **Funding:** Sponsorship, or able to self-fund or meet any cost-sharing requirements if applicable (to be confirmed post-selection).
- Agree to comply with Skate Australia policies (Code of Conduct, Integrity & Anti-Doping, Member Protection, etc.) and World Skate regulations.
- Current World Skate Infinity Profile

## What to Submit

1. **Results CV (2024–2025 competitions)** – include event name, date, location, discipline/division, placing, and field size.
2. **Video Submission (60–120 seconds)** – demonstrating competition-ready lines appropriate to Park or Street. Submit via unlisted link (YouTube, Vimeo, Instagram, Facebook, Tik Tok etc.).
3. **Athlete Details** – name, DOB, nationality, city/state, phone, email, Skate Australia membership number, division(s) nominated, coach/club, sponsors, social media, profile pic
4. **Declarations** – confirm eligibility, compliance with policies if selected, and availability to compete.
5. **If no results in 2024/2025 provide Competition results prior to 2024** – As well as an explanation as to why you haven't competed in the last two years.
6. **Certificates of participation from events** – If provided by event

## Selection Process

Selections will be made by the CEO, considering:

- demonstrated competition results (2024–2025)
- technical difficulty, execution, consistency, and line composition
- overall readiness for international standard competition
- Skate Australia's discretion

**Final selections will be confirmed by 5:00 pm, 8 September 2025.**

Athletes selected will be notified directly.
